- 4. How would you characterize Kozole's directing style? How does he approach the high-stakes moments in the film?
- 5. Do you think **A CALL GIRL** is a political film? If so, what might it be saying about the current state of Slovenia?
- 6. Discuss Alexandra's relationship with her father. Do you see any similarities between them?
- 7. How do you think Alexandra's future will unfold?
