SHORT SYNOPSIS

Animals in War is a feature film consisting of seven incredible rescue stories united by kindness and hope. The film tells about ordinary Ukrainians who never abandon their own and are always ready to help.

From the touching story of a boy escaping an occupied village together with a cow, to an underwater fairy tale unfolding against a sea destroyed by war, to the journey of a young man from Kyiv and his cat, each story offers a separate human perspective on war, responsibility, and compassion.

LONG SYNOPSIS

Animals in War is a feature anthology film created by Ukrainian filmmakers in response to Russia's full scale invasion of Ukraine. The film consists of seven independent novellas. The stories do not intersect narratively, yet they are united by a shared emotional and ethical space.

Each novella focuses on an animal and the people whose lives become connected to it under the pressure of war. War is portrayed not as spectacle, but as a humanitarian and ecological catastrophe that destroys lives, nature, and inner stability. Alongside devastation, the film reveals tenderness, moral choice, and responsibility for those who depend on us.

Children forced to grow up overnight, adults living with loss, people under occupation making impossible decisions all encounter animals that become witnesses, companions, and sometimes the only reason to survive. Blending realism with poetic imagery, and at times approaching allegory and fairy tale, Animals in War shows how compassion remains possible even in the darkest circumstances.

PROJECT BACKGROUND AND DEVELOPMENT

Work on Animals in War began in early 2022. The first novellas featuring a white rabbit, a wolf, and a cow were filmed by the end of the same year.

In February 2023, on the anniversary of the beginning of the full scale invasion, the first teaser created from three completed stories was presented at the Berlin International Film Festival.

In May 2023, during the 76th Cannes Film Festival, the project unveiled its first official poster and trailer. At that stage, Academy Award winner Sean Penn joined the film, followed later by the internationally renowned band Imagine Dragons, whose hit song became the soundtrack of Animals in War.

The segment starring Sean Penn was filmed in autumn 2023 at Evergreen Studios in Los Angeles and was written and directed by Myroslav Slaboshpytskyi.
